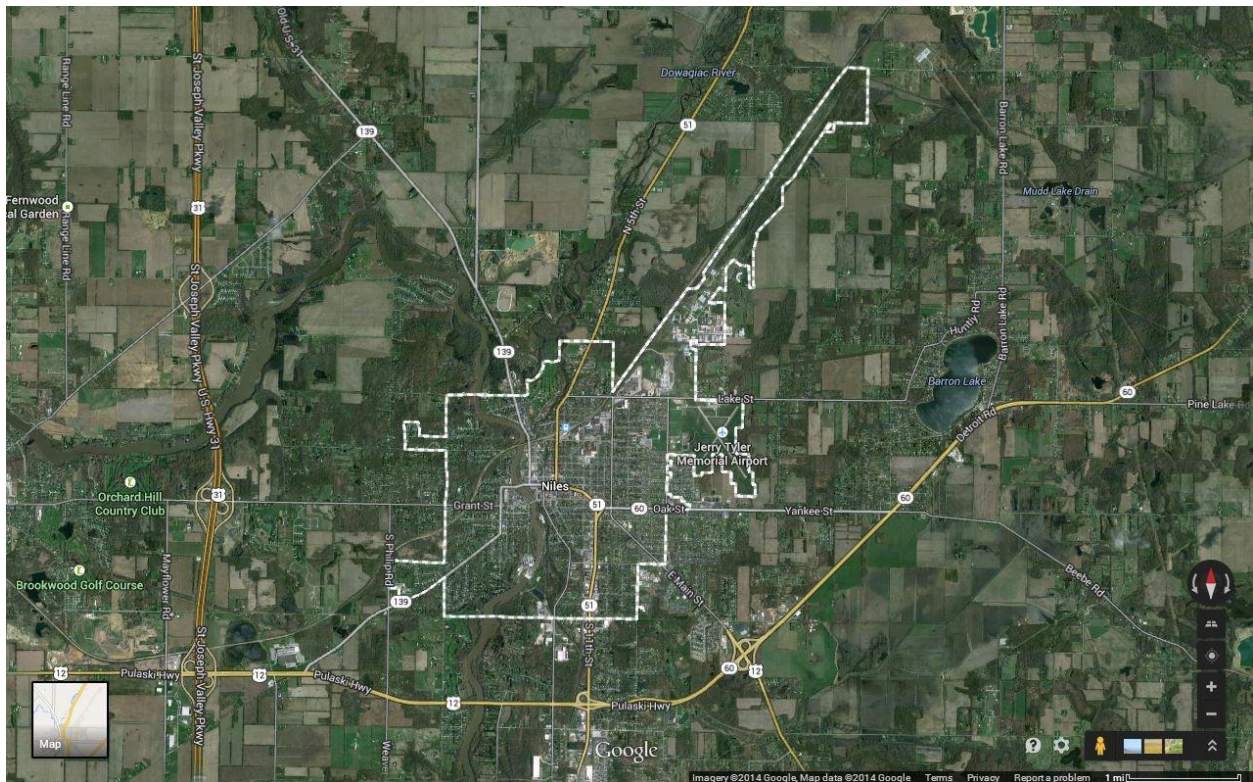

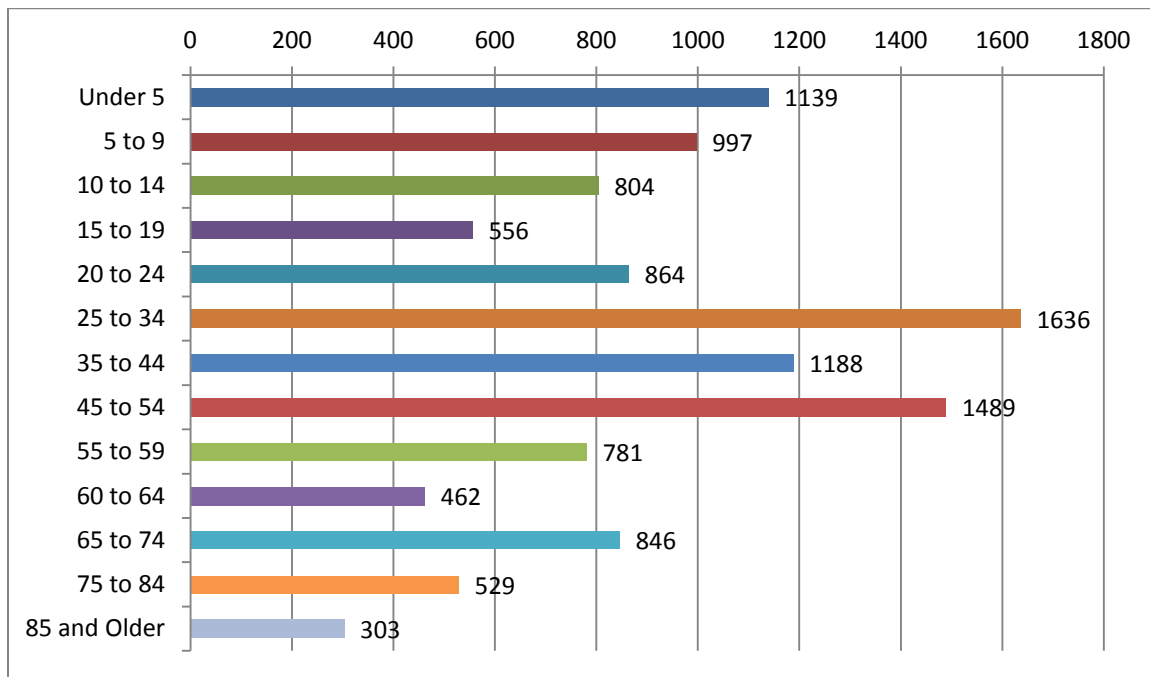

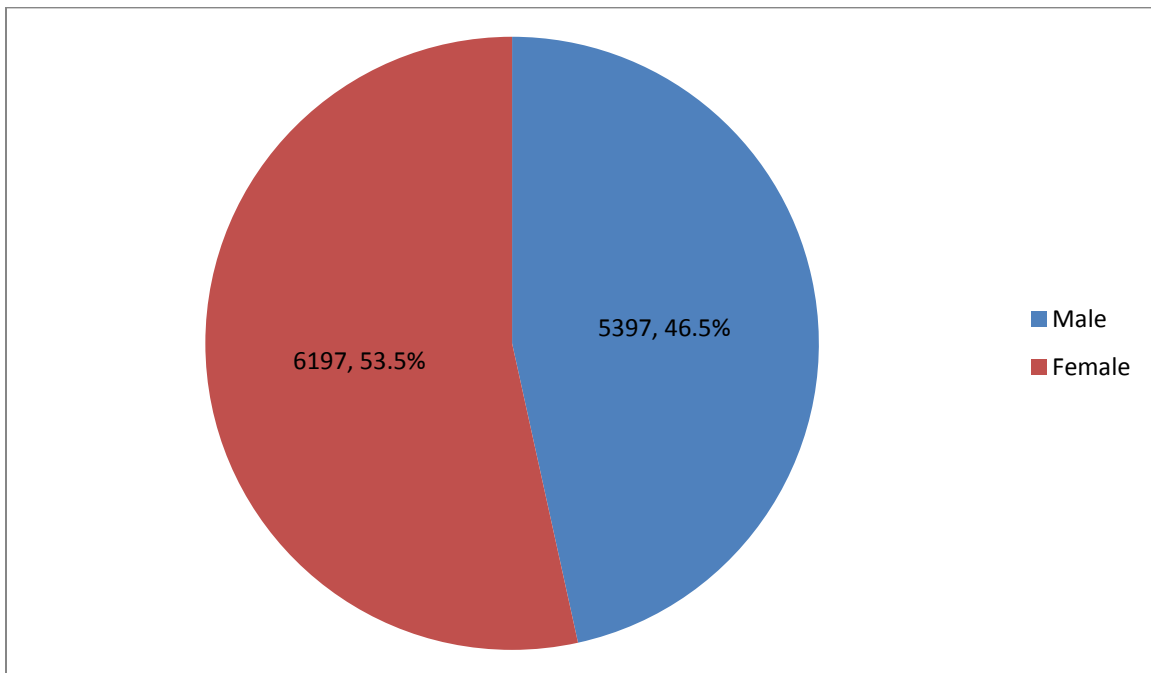

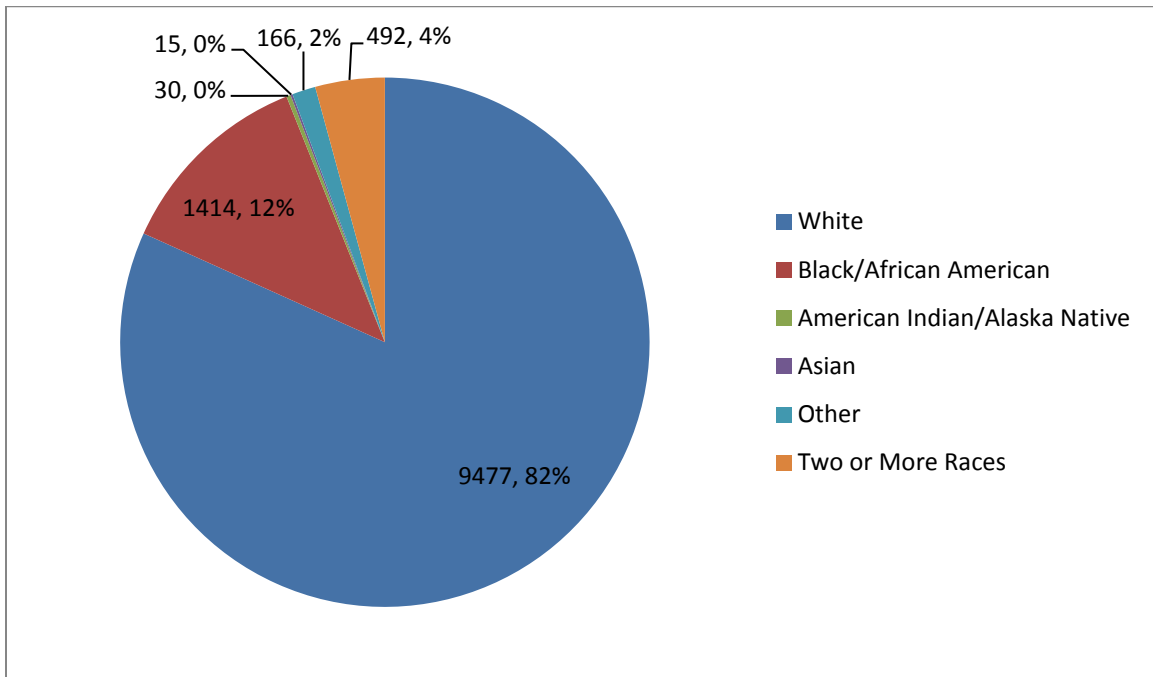

GENDER



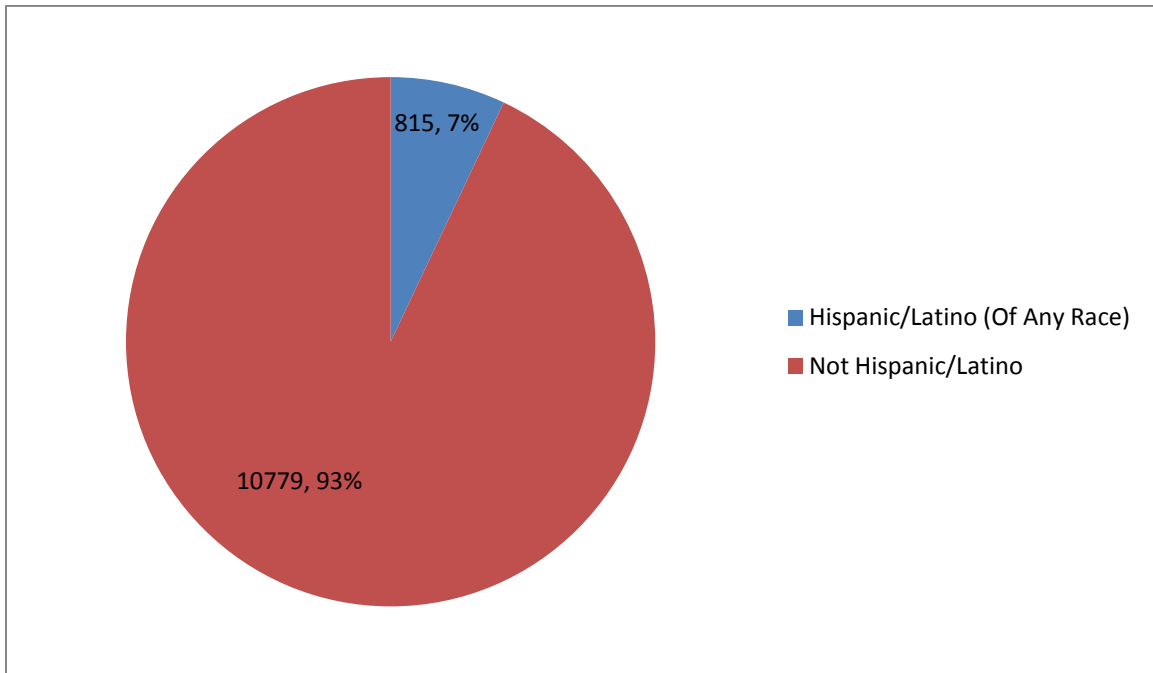

HISPANIC/LATINO STATUS

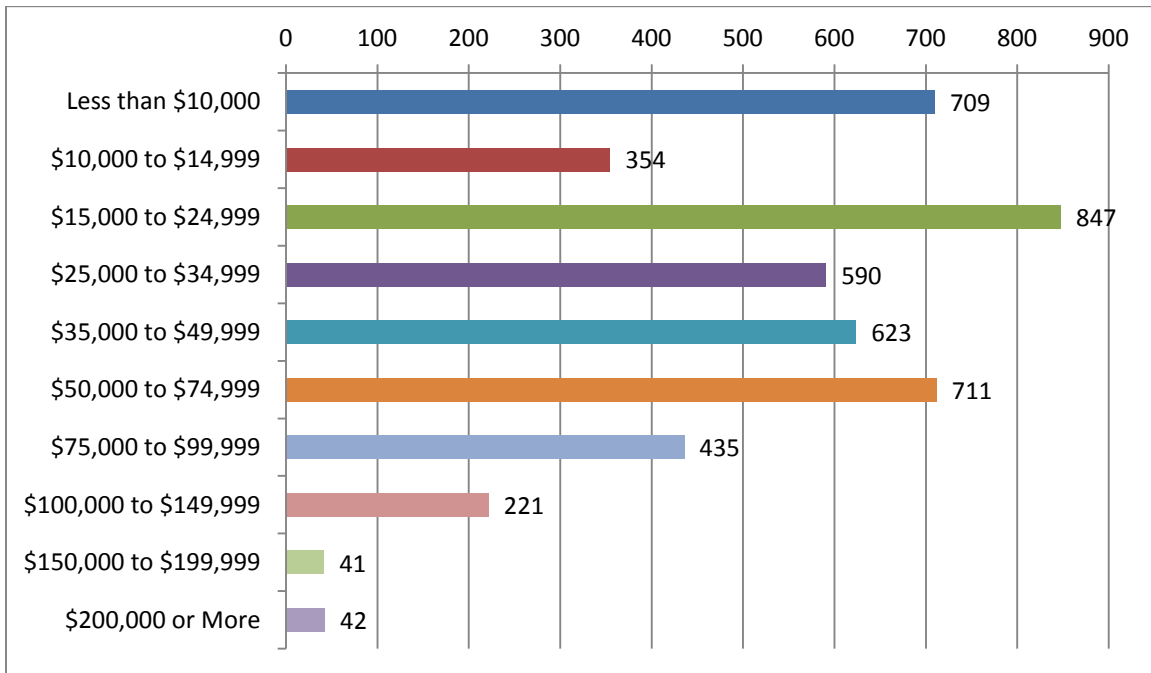

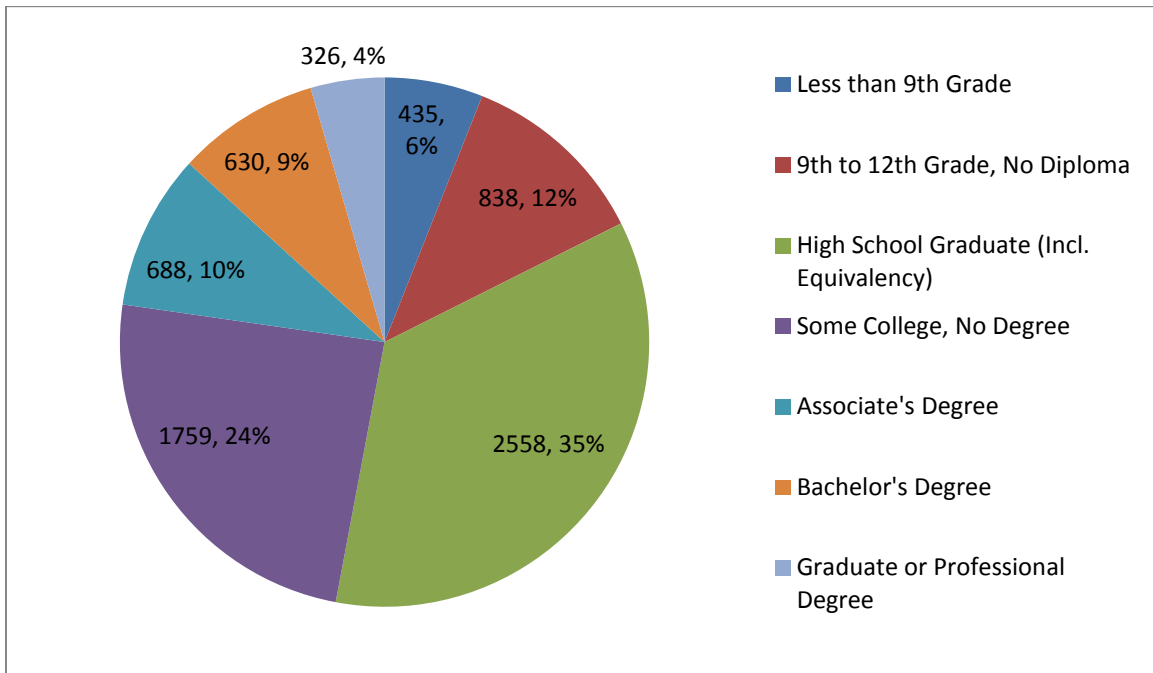

EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, POPULATION 25 YEARS AND OVER

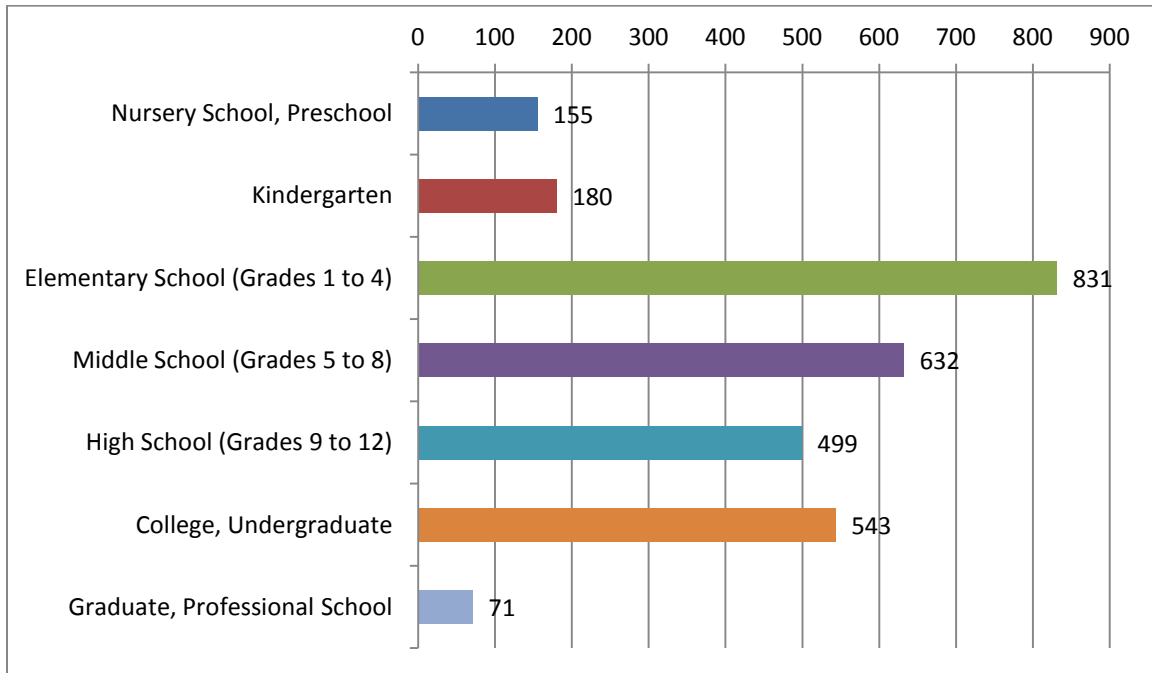
Percent High School Graduate or Higher: 82.4%

Percent Bachelor's Degree or Higher: 13.2%



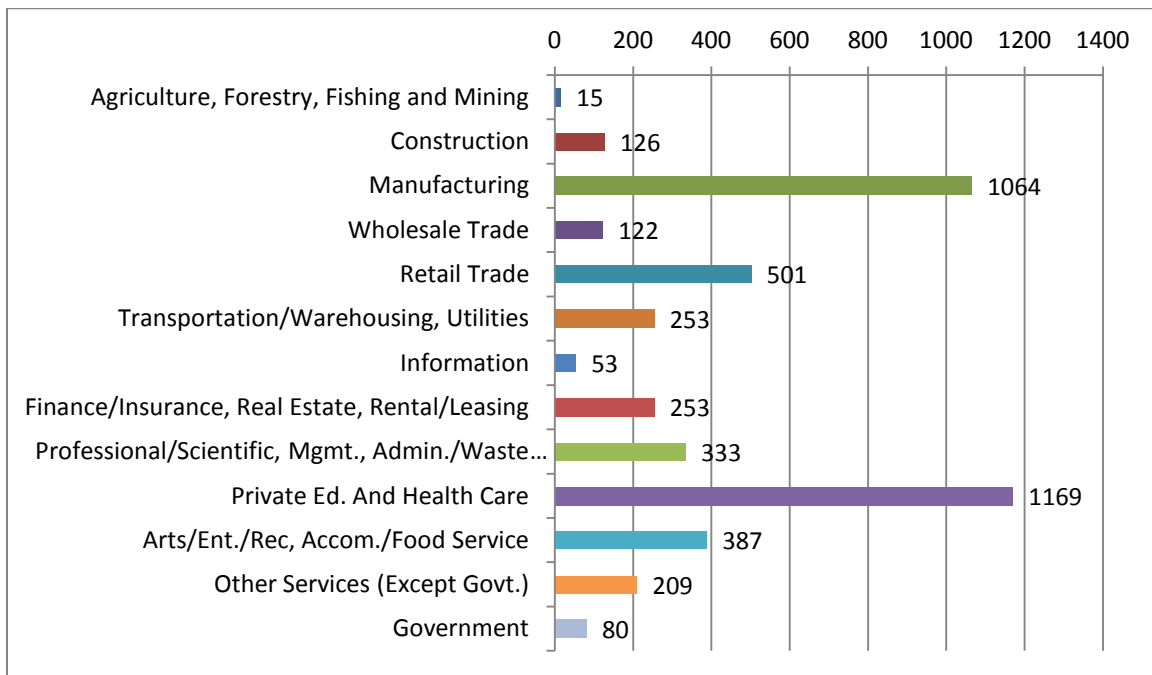

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT, POPULATION 3 YEARS AND OVER ENROLLED IN SCHOOL



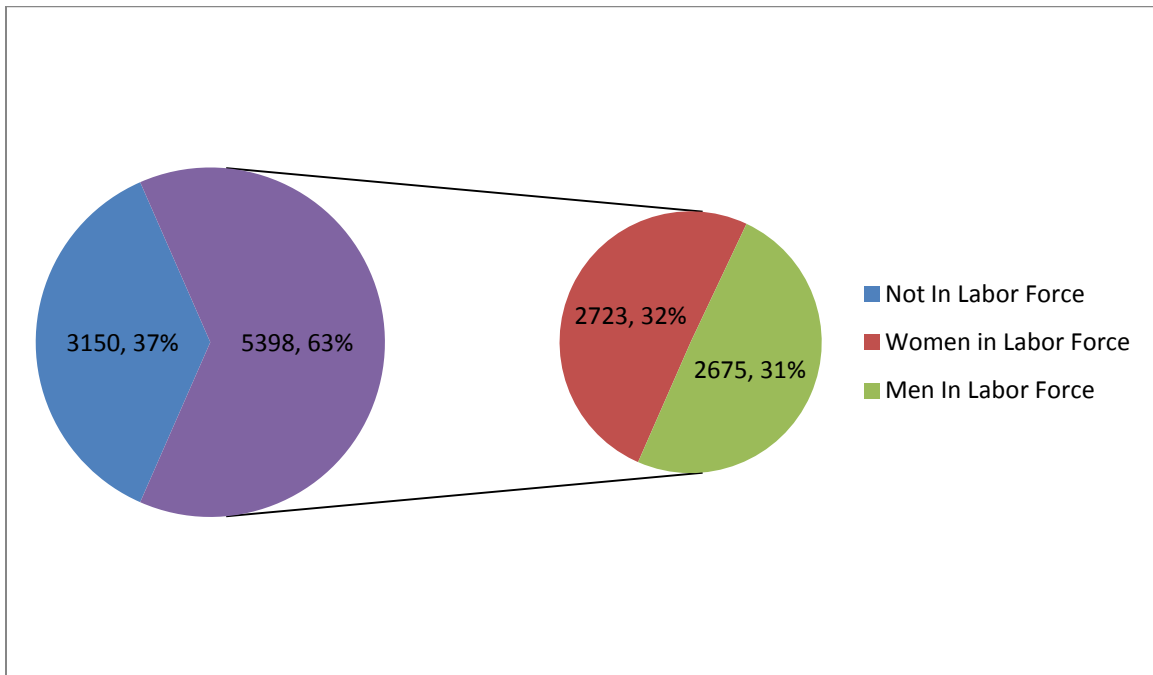

INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT



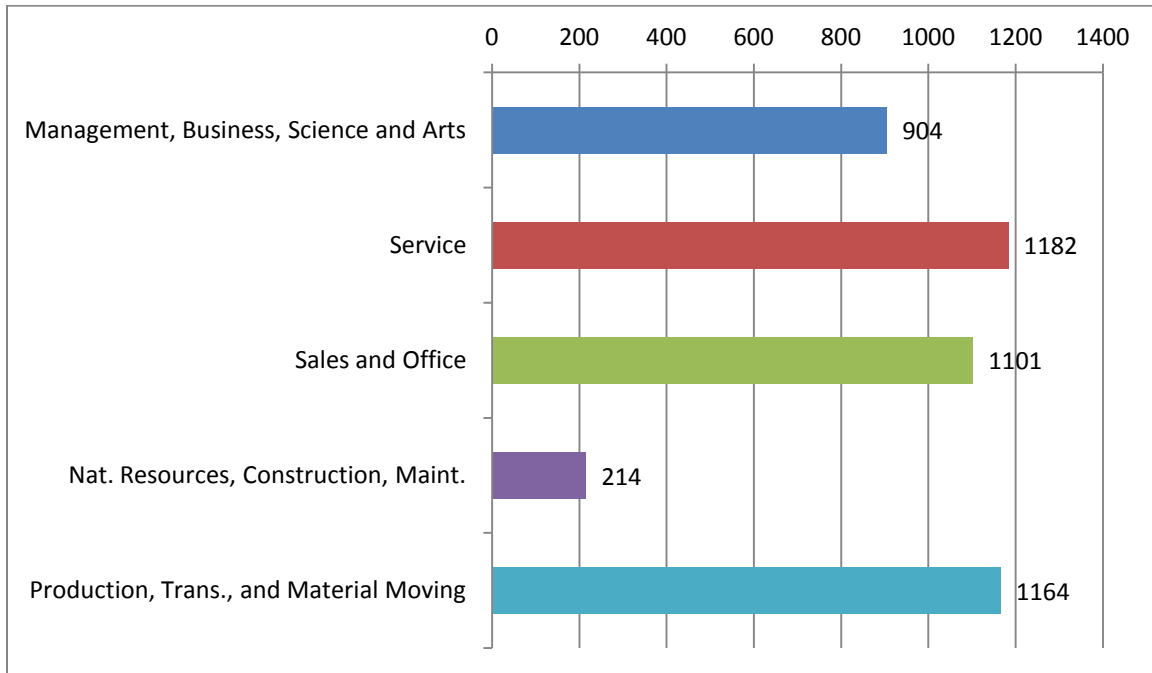
