





GENDER






RACE/ETHNICITY

HISPANIC/LATINO STATUS








EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, POPULATION 25 YEARS AND OVER






SCHOOL ENROLLMENT, POPULATION 3 YEARS AND OVER ENROLLED IN SCHOOL




