NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE PY 15 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

A public hearing will be held on September 14, 2015 at 5:55 p.m., at the City of Niles Fire Department and Council Chambers, 1345 E Main Street, Niles, MI, to obtain the views of citizens concerning housing and community development needs of the City, which are included within the City of Niles Community Development Block Grant 2015 Annual Action Plan.

The City of Niles expects to receive about \$270,000 in CDBG funds for program year 2015 (October 1, 2015 – September 30, 2016) and to reallocate an estimated \$30,000 in prior year funds for the purposes of undertaking a variety of projects meeting one of the three national objectives – 1) benefit low and moderate income persons, 2) aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight, or 3) meet other community development needs having a particular urgency. The proposed projects include Infrastructure (\$90,000); Code Enforcement (\$60,000), Homeowner Assistance Program (\$56,000); Public Services (\$40,000) and Administration and Planning (\$54,000). Main St, Niles, MI.
