Each member of the team plays a critical role in ensuring that everyone who is eligible to vote is able to cast a ballot.

Requirements:

- ★ You must be qualified and registered elector of the State of Michigan
- ★ You must submit a completed application to the local clerk
- ★ You must go through the provided paid training

Election Inspectors are PAID positions and can earn as much as \$100 for the day plus a meal.
